## What's Happening In...

### 3rd Grade

In 3rd grade, students are comparing and contrasting the life cycles of different living organisms. So far, we have learned about the life cycles of plants, earthworms, salmon, and ladybugs. Currently, we are observing the life cycle of a caterpillar to a butterfly! We released ladybugs into the garden before break, and will do the same when our butterflies are full grown! We are also discovering why animals often live in groups for survival and how certain animals can survive in extreme weather conditions. In math, we learned how to find the perimeter and area of different polygons and will begin reviewing all the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade math standards in preparation to rock the CAASPP! Coming up, students are excited to visit the Fresno Art Museum to experience how artists use elements of art in their work.
